- Research on relevant issues of giftedness and support (e.g. teacher talent beliefs)

- Development of initial and further teacher education
- Contribution to school and curriculum development (e.g. teaching methods for supporting gifted students)
- Embedding talent support and research in the curricula of initial and further teacher education
- (Founding) member in networks and research associations (e.g. International Panel of Experts for Gifted Education – iPEGE)
