The Institute for Educational Science comprises all teachers in the fields of educational science, educational research and school pedagogy, educational psychology and teacher personality, sociology of education, inclusion pedagogy, vocational pedagogy and elementary education.

The central goals of the Institute for Educational Science are, on the one hand, the development of education in the field of educational science and, on the other hand, the coordination of the research agendas of the University of Education Salzburg.

This results in the following tasks:

- Implementing measures for the professionalisation of teaching in the educational sciences (e.g. through exchange in the departments, further training events for teachers in training, expert discussions).
- Coordinating teaching activities in the various training areas
- Collaboration in the development of new training curricula
- Promotion of Austrian and international networks of the teachers in training
- Drawing up staff development plans in cooperation with the responsible vice rector
- Development, implementation, stimulation and coordination of research in the field of education at the University of Education Salzburg Stefan Zweig
- Further development of pedagogical practice
- The Institute of Educational Science is divided into departments as required. The departments are defined separately in a flexible organisation plan.
